Notes to the Precept Budget

Item 1 – Clerk's salary: The councillors voted unanimously to increase the Clerk's salary w.e.f. 01.04.19 by £65 p.a. – see Minute Ref. 100/18

Item 2 – breakdown of administrative expenses paid by the Clerk and reclaimed from the council - £715.14 estimated in 2018/2019

- Ink cartridges: Epson ink cartridges cost around £47 for a pack of 4 inks. The Clerk is instead purchasing compatible inks (which cause difficulties) but costs around £15 per pack. Ink cartridge costs for 2018/2019 are estimated at £88.37
- Travel expenses allowed at 45p per mile. In addition to attending meetings, the Clerk travels to Condover to the auditor, and on occasions to the Shirehall. Travel expenses for 2018/2019 are estimated at £215.50
- Electricity for heating at venues estimated expenditure for 2018/2019 at £30.00
- Postage estimated expenditure for 2018/2019 is £45.24.
- Stationery estimated expenditure for 2018/2019 is £21.43
- Broadband & telephone. The parish council is serviced by the Clerk's personal telephone and Broadband connection which for the past year has cost her approximately £700, to which the parish council will have contributed £203.10 by 31.03.18.

 The Clerk asks that the parish council increases it contribution from £15 per month to £20, making a total of £240 per annum.
- IT support. The Clerk has had heavy reliance on IT support during 2018/2019, totalling £100.00. £60 related to work necessary for compliance with the Data Protection regulations and £40 has been caused by on-going faults and problems caused by the poor Broadband signal available in Leinthall Earls currently 0.94 mgbits.

Taking the above figures into account, the Clerk recommends a sum of £750 for the 2019/2020 Precept Budget to cover the cost of administrative expenses/consumables/IT support with a small excess for any contingencies.

<u>Item 11 – Match Funding for the Environmental Maintenance Grant</u>

The councillors discussed this matter on 19.11.19 and resolved to seek an Environmental Maintenance Grant of just £250 for the financial year 2019/2020 and to match fund with £250 from the Precept. See Minute ref. 100/18.

<u>Item 12 – possible purchase of a Speed Awareness Sign</u>

This was discussed at length. The councillors resolved to leave this matter in abeyance for this forthcoming financial year but to re-visit it in 2020/2021. See Minute Ref. 100/18.

RESERVES brought forward from 2018/2019 will be approximately £2,665.00

A PRECEPT TO COVER THE PARISH COUNCIL'S 2019/2020 ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS WILL NEED TO BE SET AT £4,435.68 plus £250 to match fund the Environmental Grant, making a total Precept of £4,686

This will enable the parish council to meet its projected annual overheads with provision being made for increased administrative costs. It includes no provision for item 12.

EFFECT ON COUNCIL TAX - BAND D - Figures not yet available from Shropshire Council

Last year the **2018/2019 Precept** of £4,556 resulted in a Council Tax Band D Parish Council Charge of £24.83, an increase over 2017/2018 of £3.51

A Precept Budget of £4,686 for Financial Year 2019/2020 will result in a Council Tax Band D charge of £25.46, an increase over 2018/2019 of £0.63. Any additional charge over and above £4,686 will cost £0.54 per £100.
